

Aviation Department

Even though passenger traffic was up 7% YTD October at ACY, its air travel showed a slowdown compared to previous months. The traffic for October was flat with a tepid 0.4% increase. Spirit Airlines, the airport's dominant carrier, experienced a decline of 4% even though the seat capacity remained flat. With United leaving the airport in December and Atlantic City experiencing economic challenges, next year's outlook for the passenger traffic at ACY could be challenging. ACY should end the year with growth of about 6.5% due to strong gains in the beginning of the year.
