

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ OCTOBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic rose 8.5 percent, boosted by a 9.4 percent increase in the international sector. The domestic sector grew 7.6 percent. YTD performance continues to grow at around 6.7 percent, putting JFK on track for another record-breaking year in both the domestic and international markets. Airlines expanded domestic capacity by 3.7 percent, led by Delta's 7.3 percent expansion. AA and JetBlue also were net contributors. Carriers expanded international seat capacity by 7.4 percent. Emirates, JetBlue, and Virgin Atlantic added a combined 64,107 passengers. JFK's cargo was down 2.3 percent in October.
