

October regional passenger traffic will be up 0.4% over last year. The drop in passenger growth, we believe, may be a one month event caused mostly by Hurricane Wilma which caused havoc with Florida traffic. Aviation Daily reported that JetBlue and Delta cut 3.6% of their October flights due to Wilma. Many airlines were also cutting seat capacity due to two factors: Hurricane Katrina's affect on Gulf coast refineries and resultant further spiking in the price of jet fuel.
