

## Aviation Department

Passenger traffic, down 0.9%, was weighed down by Continental, which flew a total of 0.5% fewer passengers, 3.0% fewer on its mainline unit and 8.3% more on its commuter partners. Number two at Newark, American Airlines saw traffic drop 4.5% on 6.3% less capacity. International traffic, down 3.8%, was negatively affected by Continental's cuts to markets in Western Europe.
