

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic increased 1.0%, the first uptick since last August, even as seat capacity was cut 5.5%. Delta saw traffic increase 0.8%, mostly on the strength of commuter operations. JetBlue's push into the Caribbean produced strong results as that market was up 23.2%, even as American Airlines and Air Jamaica retreated. Transatlantic traffic was flat.
