

Aviation Department

September traffic was down 0.5% and YTD Sept. growth was also down 0.6%. YTD September international passenger traffic grew 6.1% and continued to lead the airport's passenger growth, supported by a 2.1% seat capacity increase. Continental, the airport's dominant carrier, increased international seat capacity by 2.2% and carried nearly 300,000 more passengers. YTD September domestic traffic decline of 3.7%. However, the decrease in the pace of domestic decline may signal potential future improvement. YTD Sept cargo growth remained strong at 14.9%.
