

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ SEPTEMBER 2012 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

YTD Sept. passenger grew 2.8%. Growth was attributable to strong domestic growth generated in the first four months of the year emanating from capacity expansion by Southwest, JetBlue and United. This propelled YTD Sept. domestic growth to 5.2%, but international continued to be weak, falling 1.5% as of YTD Sept. The international weakness was due to the absence of Eva, Air France (which recently consolidated at JFK), Iceland Express and the temporary suspension of Air India, and 27% passenger decline from Alitalia. This caused transatlantic and transpacific traffic regions to carry 281,000 fewer passengers, representing a decline of 4.3% and 7.7% respectively. YTD cargo was down 8.6%.
