

Aviation Department

JFK's YTD Sept. passenger traffic was up 5.6 %. JFK's growth was led by the international sector where YTD Sept. traffic grew 7.2% and is on pace to set a new international record. Growth was led by incumbent carriers JetBlue, Delta, Norwegian and Emirates, who collectively added a net of 656,000 passengers. YTD domestic traffic at JFK is up 3.7% due primarily to Delta's 9.1% capacity gain to several destinations, including Jacksonville, Minneapolis, Los Angeles, San Francisco and West Palm Beach. With Sept. YTD 2.0% growth JFK cargo is leading the region's cargo recovery primarily due to the 3.7% gain in international cargo. YTD domestic cargo is down 4.8%.
