

## Aviation Department

JFK is on pace for another record year led by the domestic sector's YTD Sept. gain of 7.4% on a 6% seat capacity boost. Incumbent carriers, Delta, JetBlue, and American, along with Virgin America, who collectively added a net of 1.3 million passengers, led domestic growth in order. Delta accounted for more than half of the net gain as it expanded seat capacity by 9.4 %, mostly to Florida destinations, Boston, Syracuse and Minneapolis/St. Paul. Boosted by a 3.1% gain in seat capacity, YTD Sept. international passenger traffic grew 5.8%, and is on pace to set a new international record. With YTD Sept cargo down 0.7%, JFK is no longer the growth front runner, it has relinquished that role to EWR.
