

Regional passenger traffic increased 2.0%, led by JFK with a 6.3% gain, followed by EWR at 1.1% and LGA at (3.8%), These results compare to a 2005 hurricane Katrina affected base. Our international traffic growth matched that of the US flag carrier average of 4.2%, while our regional domestic traffic exceeded the national average (.9% to (1.9%). Freight increased 0.6%.
