Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

It's a record year, but recent trends reflect a downward direction.

Note: with regard to the ranking report on page 2, at LGA US Airways shuttle traffic was combined with US Airways traffic from July 2000 onward. At JFK, traffic for Tower and Jet Blue reflect less than a full year of operation.
