

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ OCTOBER 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at ACY reached its highest growth rate of 2016 – 7.6 percent – up 6,156 passengers. The improvement was led by a 7.6 percent (6,177 passengers) gain in domestic passenger. Spirit, the dominant carrier at ACY, registered a 9.5 percent increase, or 6,747 additional passengers. Spirit grew its seats by 14.9 percent – 12,816 added seats. Atlanta, Fort Lauderdale, Fort Myers, Orlando, and Tampa all experienced double-digit increases in seats. International passenger traffic was down by 4.7 percent (21 international charter passengers).
