

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ SEPTEMBER 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Passenger traffic at ACY grew by 2.4 percent. Spirit, the dominant carrier at the airport, grew 3.8 percent as it carried 2,732 additional domestic passengers. Spirit grew its seat capacity by 11.2 percent (up 10,042 seats). While Atlanta, Fort Lauderdale, Fort Myers, Orlando and Tampa saw double-digit increases in seats (a combined addition of 11,320 seats), Boston, Chicago, and Detroit saw a joint reduction of 1,278 seats. International traffic fell 53.7 percent. This fall was largely due to Air Canada's cessation of operations at ACY. In September of 2015, Air Canada carried 315 international passengers.
