

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ OCTOBER 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

JFK's total passenger traffic reached a record 4.9 million passengers. International traffic led the increase with a 3.3 percent gain – up 85,364 passengers. Airlines added 175,130 international seats (+5.3 percent). Domestic passenger traffic decreased 3.2 percent – down 75,429 passengers. This decline was largely due to United's cessation of operations at JFK (in October 2015, United carried 76,666 passengers). Domestic seat capacity fell by 2.3 percent. JFK's total cargo activity inched up 2.2 percent. Growth was led by the international sector which grew by 3.3 percent – a gain of 3,263 additional tons. The domestic sector, which accounts for approximately 18 percent of JFK's total cargo movement, decline 2.9 percent – down 648 tons.
