JFK's total passenger traffic increased 7.2 percent, and set a record for September as it handled 5.1 million passengers. The domestic sector led the growth with an 11.5 percent increase. Delta was the top contributor to JFK's domestic passenger increase, handling 358,045 additional passengers. The international sector grew 3.6 percent. Qatar Airways, Air Portugal, Norwegian Air, and China Eastern were the top contributors to JFK's international passenger gain, handling a combined 60,155 additional passengers. Domestic carriers cut their seat capacity by 0.1 percent. Airlines expanded international seats by 5.2 percent. JFK's cargo activity rose 5.6 percent in September. Domestic sector, which accounts for 18 percent of its cargo traffic, increased 18.6 percent. International cargo improved by 2.8 percent.
