LGA's total passenger traffic bounced back modestly from its July's 2.5 percent drop. Growth was led by the international sector which grew 2.7 percent, up 4,937 additional passengers and reversing the negative performance of the previous four months. The domestic sector, which accounts for over 90 percent of LGA's total passenger traffic, was unchanged. LGA experienced fewer full planes and a lower load factor as airlines increased domestic seat capacity by 2.8 percent, or 84,844 additional seats. For the second month in a row, LGA's total freight movement posted a double-digit growth rate (13.1 percent) while recording the third highest growth rate among our airports. Growth was totally sustained by domestic cargo which posted a solid 13.1 percent improvement, as international cargo activity was flat.
