Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

The region's passenger total grew by 2.2 percent and set another record for the month of August as it reached 12.4 million passengers – a net gain of 265,076 travelers compared to August 2015. This modest increase is a stark contrast with the solid pace of the first half of 2016 and continues the narrative of slower growth for the rest of the year. For the second month in a row, the international sector led growth with a 2.6 percent increase and set a record of 4.8 million passengers. Domestic traffic, too, set a new mark for the month of August, growing 1.9 percent. Airlines increased their seats by 4.3 percent. The region's total cargo activity bounced back solidly following July's modest fall as it recorded its second monthly increase of 2016. Growth was led by a solid 13.5 percent expansion in domestic freight activity. Also contributing to the region's overall freight growth was international cargo, approximately 64 percent of the region's total freight movement, which grew by 1.4 percent.
