

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ AUGUST 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

SWF's total passenger traffic continues to struggle as it recorded its fifth consecutive monthly decline – down 4 percent – or 1,072 fewer passengers. The decline was led by a combined drop of 3,504 passengers by Delta, American/US Airways, and JetBlue. Though Allegiant Air carried an additional 2,432 passengers – up 89.3 percent – this gain was insufficient to cover the deficit caused by the other three airlines. Airlines cut seat capacity by 4.3 percent – down 1,346 seats. Stewart's total freight activity recorded its seventh consecutive monthly double-digit gain as it grew by 20.1 percent – the highest growth rate among our airports. Growth was totally driven by the domestic sector as there was no international cargo movement.
