

## THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ DECEMBER 2015 TRAFFIC REPORT

### Aviation Department

For the fourth consecutive year, SWF's passenger volume declined. The mid-Hudson Valley airport served 281,754 passengers for a decline of 8.9 %, following a 3.5 % drop in 2014. As we have stated previously, SWF's traffic levels always have had a tendency to swing wildly, primarily because of the limited number of carriers and flights. As a result, small changes in seats, routes or services have an amplified impact on traffic levels. The 2015 decline is due primarily to a 10 % capacity retrenchment and lower load factors that caused the airport to carry nearly 28,000 fewer passengers. Stewart's cargo also fell 2.4 %, due primarily to a reduction in shipments by UPS and FedEx.
