

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ SEPTEMBER 2016 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Total passenger traffic at SWF grew 1.4 percent – up 328 additional passengers. The 1.9 percent improvement was led by Allegiant Air, which carried 2,801 additional passengers. On the other hand, Delta registered a 34.6 percent (2,415 passengers) fall in passenger traffic. Airlines increased their domestic seats by 4 percent. Stewart's cargo movement registered the highest growth rate among our airport as it grew 43.9 percent – up 583 additional tons. Growth was totally by the domestic sector as there was no international cargo activity. As in previous months, the main driver of this improvement was FedEx, which transported 405 additional tons for a 43.6 percent increase.
