



Holland Tunnel Concrete Repairs

Project Background

Starting Sunday, May 8, 2016, The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey will begin a two-year, estimated \$9.7 million project to repair the air supply ports inside the Holland Tunnel.

Scope of Work

The work will include repairs to concrete, ensuring a state of good repair.

Schedule

To accommodate construction work, overnight single tunnel lane closures may be required in both directions, beginning Sunday, May 8, 2016, and continuing through June 2018.

Traffic Impacts

Sunday through Thursday Overnight

New Jersey-bound Holland Tunnel traffic, especially at the intersections of Varick and Watts Street, Varick and Broome Street, and Hudson and Canal Street approaches in Manhattan, could experience some heavy congestion during weeknight lane closures. Port Authority Police will be on hand to direct traffic. Motorists may want to consider alternate routes during these times.

Saturday and Sunday Morning

Minor traffic delays are expected weekend mornings, in both the New Jersey-bound and New York-bound directions.
