DESCRIPTION: Hurricane preparedness is critical to protect people and property from the potential destruction of an impending weather event. The intent of the work is to protect the World Trade Center (WTC) site from threats posed by an impending weather event with an accompanying storm surge, such as a hurricane, tropical storm, and or Nor'easter that could threaten WTC facilities. The Port Authority has developed best practices plan and procedures. The Scope of Work under this contract includes providing all labor, equipment, tools to implement those plans, which are outlined in Part V of the Bid Documents.

NOTE: The Contract may be federally funded in whole or in part by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) or Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). Accordingly, FTA/FEMA Requirements are part of the agreement and may be applicable to this work.
