Contract WTC-964.945 – World Trade Center (WTC) Flood Mitigation and Resiliency Improvements Program –WIPS at grade - between West Street and Greenwich Street.

Estimate Range: \$10M - \$20M. Bids Due **Thursday, August 3, 2017**. The work under this contract consists generally of providing and installing at grade Water Intrusion Protection Systems (WIPS) at the perimeter off the WTC Vehicular Security Center. Work includes any modifications to building and roadway surfaces, provisions for egress, and flood emergency signage.

ONLY FIRMS WHO CAN DEMONSTRATE THAT THEY COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING PREREQUISITES SHOULD SUBMIT BIDS

- The Bidder must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Port Authority that it has the relevant experience and capability to construct a project of this type. The Bidder shall fulfill this requirement by providing verifiable references for one (1) projects completed within the past four (4) years of similar size, type and complexity.
- Project Superintendent must have ten (10) years of verifiable experience in general construction work of similar size and complexity, as a Project Superintendent.

A Bid submitted by a bidder who does not meet the prerequisite requirements will be considered non-responsive and the bidder's Bid will not be eligible for acceptance by the Authority.

This project may be funded, in whole or in part, by a grant from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), and this procurement and contract are subject to applicable FTA requirements.
