Contract WTC-964.960 – World Trade Center (WTC) Flood Mitigation and Resiliency Improvements Program –Pumps and Water Removal Systems. Estimate Range: \$1M - \$5M. **Bids Due Tuesday, February 27, 2018.** The contract work consists of furnishing and installation of a Pumps and Water Removal Systems for the extraction of storm floodwater entering the below grade West Bathtub and South Bathtubs and ground water for the protection of critical rooms including but not limited to vehicular and roadway ramps and vicinity VSC areas (South Bathtub) and the WTC Transportation Hub (West Bathtub).

ONLY FIRMS WHO CAN DEMONSTRATE THAT THEY COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING PREREQUISITES SHOULD SUBMIT BIDS

- 1) The Bidder must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Port Authority that it has the relevant experience, lead mechanical trade and capability to construct a project of this type i.e. pumps, piping & associated electrical work. The Bidder shall fulfill this requirement by providing verifiable references for one (1) project completed within the past four (4) years of similar size, type and complexity.
- 2) Project Superintendent must have ten (10) years of verifiable experience in general construction work of similar size and complexity, as a Project Superintendent.

A Bid submitted by a bidder who does not meet the prerequisite Qualification Information requirements will be considered non-responsive.
