**The following changes are hereby made to the solicitation document:**

### Attachment A, Scope of Services:

1. On page 2, TASK A: ON-CALL ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES – RETAIL, under “**III. DESCRIPTION OF CONSULTANT’S TASKS**”, insert the following bullet point:
  - Interact, coordinate and confer with other Port Authority design consultants, including Structural, MEP, Code Analysis, Telecommunications, Design Criteria, etc., as needed. 2. On page 3, under “**III. DESCRIPTION OF CONSULTANT’S TASKS**”, delete the phrase “TASK B: CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY AND ADMINISTRATION – RETAIL” and replace with “TASK B: CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY ADMINISTRATION AND PROJECT CONTROL SERVICES – RETAIL”.
3. On page 7, TASK G: SITE WIDE INTEGRATION, under “**III. DESCRIPTION OF CONSULTANT’S TASKS**”, insert the following after the second line:

“The WTC Site Wide Integration Program is an interface of all WTC project designers, assuring that labeling and leveling naming standards are set and consistent throughout the entire WTC project. As such, the WTC Retail program is required to support these objectives as it relates to changes made to or affecting the Retail program.”
4. On page 8, delete the entire text of “Sub-Task C” in TASK G: SITE WIDE INTEGRATION, under “**III. DESCRIPTION OF CONSULTANT’S TASKS**” and substitute therefor “NOT USED”.

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your response to the above-referenced RFP upon submission.

In case any Respondent fails to conform to these instructions, its submission will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
