**The following changes are hereby made to the solicitation document:**

### **I. RFQS SOLICITATION DOCUMENT**

**A. Delete Section V., Paragraph B, Subparagraph 5. entitled “QA/QC Procedures”, on page 8 in its entirety and replace with the following:**

“Submit a detailed description of your firm’s Quality Assurance/Quality Control (QA/QC) Plan addressing the Quality Management System; QA/QC organization; how the Plan extends to subcontractors and others in the supply chain; and resources and procedures that your firm will use for evaluating quality of construction activities, products and related activities.”

### **B. PROPOSER’S QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

The following information is made available in response to questions submitted by prospective Proposer(s). It should not be deemed to answer all questions which have been submitted by Proposer(s) to the Port Authority. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no

representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its directors, officers, agents, representatives or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Proposer(s) required by this Proposal or Agreement and the Proposer(s) agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.
