SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF EXPERT PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYING - UTILITY LOCATING AND MARKING/DESIGNATING "1-CALL MARK-OUT" SERVICES AS REQUESTED ON A "CALL-IN" BASIS DURING 2014, 2015 & 2016 (RFP#38790)- ADDENDUM # 1

Dear Sir or Madam:

The following are questions from Request for Proposal (RFP) recipients. The questions and the corresponding Authority answers are provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

Question: In Attachment A, Section III, item A states, "Perform timely designating or subsurface utility engineering services consisting of answering "1-Call" Notices for Construction (Code 753) in New York and New Jersey for "mark-out" for both regular and emergency locate requests". Please confirm if this work falls under "SUE" or "standard locating"?"

Answer: This work falls under Standard Locating.

Question: What types of facilities are owned by the Authority and are required to be marked-out under this contract?

Answer: The types of facilities include but are not limited to: Water (both domestic and heat), Electric, Communication, Sanitary (Storm included), Air, and Fiber Optic.

Question: (1) In what format are your facility records? (2) Are all the facilities owned by the Authority shown in these records?

Answer: (1) Records are in the format of AutoCAD/DWG and converted to PDF. (2) Not all, but most facilities are shown in these records.

Question: Is the consultant allowed to screen and clear 1-call notices in-house or are all notices required to have a "field visit"?"

Answer: As appropriate, most notices are acceptable in-house and do not require a field visit.

Question: Will digital video be allowed of completed mark-outs, as opposed to photos & sketches?

Answer: Digital video will be allowed as long as the video is date stamped.

Question: Are the services covered under this RFP currently being outsourced?

Answer: Yes, services under the Utility designating/SUE is currently being outsourced.

The due date for receipt of Proposals remains 2:00 p.m., August 12, 2014.
