## **ADDENDUM #1**

**To prospective Bidders on Bid # 44636 - Refuse Removal, Recycling and Disposal Services for George Washington Bridge, Lincoln Tunnel And Holland Tunnel In New Jersey – Two-Year Contract**

**Due back on 12/29/15, no later than 11:00 A.M.**

### **I. CHANGES TO BID DOCUMENTS**

The following changes are hereby made to the Bid Documents:

- In Part II, “Contract Specific Information for Bidders” Page 4, Section 13, “Evaluation of Bids”, final paragraph, in the phrase “Sections I, II, and II” delete the final “II” and replace it with “III”.

### **II. BIDDERS’ QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Bidders. The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Bidders to the Port Authority. It addresses only those questions, which the Port Authority has deemed to require additional information and/or clarification. The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Bidders does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms.

The Port Authority makes no representations, warranties or guarantees that the information contained herein is accurate, complete or timely or that such information accurately represents the conditions that would be encountered during the performance of the Contract. The furnishing of such information by the Port Authority shall not create or be deemed to create any obligation or liability upon it for any reason whatsoever and each Bidder, by submitting its Bid, expressly agrees that it has not relied upon the foregoing information, and that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.

The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.

<i>Question #1</i>	Is the Contractor permitted to make Pickups at the Facilities during the overnight hours?
<i>Answer #1</i>	Overnight-hour Pickups will be permitted at the Holland Tunnel and Lincoln Tunnel, arrangements for which will be coordinated between the Contractor and the Manager at Contract commencement. The George Washington Bridge requires Pickups to be made in accordance with the Part V Specifications, Page 4, Section 4, "Work Item Specifications", "Section I, - George Washington Bridge - (Section I on Part IV Pricing Sheets)".
<i>Question #2</i>	Is Item B1, 10-cubic yard Container at the Lincoln Tunnel, a roll-off or rear-loading container?
<i>Answer #2</i>	The 10-cubic yard Container at the Lincoln Tunnel is a rear-loading container.
<i>Question #3</i>	Is subcontracting permitted under this Contract?
<i>Answer #3</i>	Yes, please see the Standard Contract Terms and Conditions, Page 14 of 29, Section 19, "Assignments and Subcontracting".
<i>Question #3</i>	Can you provide the pricing sheets for the current contract?
<i>Answer #3</i>	Please see the attached pricing sheets. These documents were not prepared for the purpose of providing information for Bidders upon the present Contract but they were prepared for other purposes, such as for other contracts or for design purposes for this or other contracts, and they do not form a part of this Contract. The Port Authority makes no representation or guarantee as to, and shall not be responsible for their accuracy, completeness or pertinence, and, in addition, shall not be responsible for the conclusions to be drawn therefrom. They are made available to the Bidders merely for the purpose of providing them with such information as is in the possession of the Port Authority whether or not such information may be accurate, complete or pertinent or of any value to the bidders.

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission.

In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
