ADDENDUM # 1

To prospective Bidder(s) on Bid # 46310: Supply and Deliver Tie Plates for 115RE Rail, and Track Joint Bars to PATH per Specifications and Drawings (FTA) - Due back on 9/8/2016, no later than 11:00 AM:

The following changes/modifications are hereby made to the solicitation document:

Document “Port Authority Trans-Hudson Corporation Specifications for Tie Plates”:

- 1) Section 1.0 “General”: Add the following as the last sentence of paragraph A:
“The Bidder shall bid on a Manufacturer which meets all the requirements specified herein.”
- 2) Section 1.01:
 - i) Delete the title “MANUFACTURER’S QUALIFICATIONS” and replace it with “BIDDER’S QUALIFICATIONS”.
 - ii) Replace paragraph A with the following:
“A. The Bidder shall bid on a manufacturer that has provided tie plates of a compatible type and design within the last five (5) years to at least one (1) railroad and/or transit agency operating in the United States.”
 - iii) Replace paragraph B with the following:
“B. The Bidder shall provide with its Bid:
 - (a) The name and business address of the manufacturer that it is bidding, and sufficient information to verify that the requirement in 1.01.A has been met; and
 - (b) The names and contact details of representatives of at least one (1) railroad and/or transit agency operating in the United States for which that manufacturer has fulfilled tie plate orders.”
 - iv) Delete paragraph C in its entirety.
- 3) Section 2.03 “Quality Assurance”:
 - i) In paragraph A., Replace the words “The Manufacturer” in the first sentence with the following:

“By making a Bid, the Bidder represents and warrants to PATH that the Manufacturer that the Bidder is Bidding”.

ii) In paragraph E., Replace the words “The Manufacturer” in the first sentence with the following:

“By making a Bid, the Bidder represents and warrants to PATH that the Manufacturer that the Bidder is Bidding”.

4) Section 3.0 “Marking and Delivery”: Replace paragraph D with the following:

“D. Material that is damaged or does not meet the requirements of the specifications will be rejected and returned to the Contractor for replacement at no additional cost to PATH.”

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission. In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
