The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Bidders does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms.

The Port Authority makes no representations, warranties or guarantees that the information contained herein is accurate, complete or timely or that such information accurately represents the conditions that would be encountered during the performance of the Contract. The furnishing of such information by the Port Authority shall not create or be deemed to create any obligation or liability upon it for any reason whatsoever and each Bidder, by submitting its Bid, expressly agrees that it has not relied upon the foregoing information, and that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder

agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.

The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.

Question #1	It seems that the result of the shortlist of pre-qualified C3M products will result in a future solicitation of C3M product(s) and then another future solicitation for integration services of the product. Is there anything else that may be procured as part of this effort?
Answer#1	No. The Authority does not anticipate that it will solicit the procurement of anything other than C3M product(s) and related services as a result of this solicitation.
Question #2	Should you move forward with a procurement, when do you anticipate a procurement to acquire C3M solutions/services?
Answer #2	It is anticipated that the Authority will issue a solicitation for the procurement of C3M solutions in the 3 rd Quarter of 2017.
Question #3	Are you looking for web based or installed software?
Answer #3	The Authority is open to either solution. Please see Section 2 "Introduction and Objective"
Question #4	What solution are currently in place and what vendor provides it?
Answer #4	Respondents attention is directed to section 2 – "Specifics".
Question #5	What are some additional drivers for the replacement project?
Answer #5	The Authority's current C3M software systems have reached their end of life.
Question #6	May companies based outside of the United States submit a Proposal?
Answer #6	Yes.

Question #7	Will the Respondents be required to attend meetings in person?
Answer #7	The Authority's preference is to have Respondents attend any Product Demo/Conference on-site at the Authority facilities, however, Respondents who qualify for further evaluation may be permitted to participate in Product Demo/Discussion via Webinar or Online Conference.
Question #8	Can the work be performed outside of the USA?
Answer #8	This a Request for Pre-Qualification. It is not anticipated that this will result in a Contract.
Question #9	May bids be submitted via email?
Answer #9	No. Proposals must be submitted in accordance with Section 6.
Question #10	Please clarify the choices under column H "Proposed System" of the 'Attachment B – Functionality Matrix'. The choices there are "Financial", "Contract Manager" or "Both". Does "Financial" refer to the "Construction Cost" system?
Answer #10	In column H, a response of Financial does mean Construction Cost System.
Question #11	How many employees will be using the software?
Answer #11	Approximately 100 users contributed data, and 400 consuming data.

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission.

In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
