The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey (the Authority) hereby amends the subject Request for Proposals (RFP), dated December 7, 2018, as follows:

A. In the RFP Letter, page 9, Section V., second and third paragraphs, replace in their entirety with the following:

Reference Documents 1 through 6 listed in Section VI.B. of Attachment A will only be made available to Bona Fide proposers to this RFP who submit the following documents and have satisfied the requirements of the Information Security Handbook:

- A. A Letter of Intent to propose on this RFP, signed by a principal of the firm on firm letterhead.
- B. A completed Attachment C, Company Profile.
- C. Execution of Non-Disclosure/Confidentially Agreement (NDA) and required acknowledgments. <u>Click here for NDA forms</u> and <u>Click here for instructions on filling</u> out the NDA forms
  - 1. Execution of a company Non-Disclosure and Confidentiality Agreement (NDA), by a Principal or authorized executive of the prime, or of the JV;
  - 2. Execution of an Exhibit A- (*Acknowledgment by a Related Party Individual*) by each individual, from all entities who will have access to the document; and
  - 3. Execution of an Exhibit B- (*Acknowledgment by a Related Individual*) by each individual. From all the entities who will have access to the documents.
- D. Proof of current valid Information Security Handbook training. Each individual who will have access to the documents must have completed Information Security Handbook Training within the last three (3) years. A copy of the sign-in sheet for an in-person training, or copy of a completion certificate from the online program, must be submitted. Click here to access the online training

As stipulated in the NDA, by its review of the listed documents, the Proposer agrees that it will not use such information for any purpose other than in response to this RFP, and that it will not disseminate such information to any third party.

- B. In the Attachment A, page 48, Section VI., first paragraph, fourth line, after "information the documents", insert the following: "1 through 6";
- C. In the Attachment A, page 50, Section VI., item B., replace number 7 in its entirety with the following:
  - "7. Washington Street Powerhouse Substation 2 Building Code and Zoning Review, October, 2018"
- D. In the Attachment A, page 50, Section VI., item B., replace number 8 in its entirety with the following:
  - "8. PATH-Washington Street Powerhouse Substation Relocation Traffic Study"

The following question was received from an RFP recipient. The question and the corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

**Question #1**: Could the Authority make available the relevant documents to qualified, screened individuals to view outside of the Authority's offices?
