## ADDENDUM # 2

To prospective Bidder(s) on Bid # 45808 for Maintenance, Repair, and Modification of Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) At Laguardia Airport (LGA)

### I. CHANGES/MODIFICATIONS

**The following changes/modifications are hereby made to the solicitation documents:**

- A. In Part II, page 3, Section 10 entitled “Specific Bidder’s Prerequisites”, delete paragraph e in its entirety.
- B. In Part II, delete Attachment II in its entirety.
- C. In Part V, page 3, Section 3 entitled “Scope of Work” , delete the third paragraph and replace it with:  
All work must comply with OSHA safety standards and the National Electrical Code. All new work or modification to the existing work must be submitted to the Manager for approval. The work, if approved, will be inspected by Port Authority Electrical staff and any discrepancies will be promptly corrected at the Contractor’s expense.
- D. In Part V, page 6, Section C) Repair Services, delete the fourth paragraph in its entirety and replace it with:  
Any materials, parts, or components required for Repair Services shall be compensated in accordance with Section IV of the Pricing Sheets, entitled “Compensation for Materials, Parts and Components”. Labor required for Repair Services shall be compensated in accordance with Section C of the Pricing Sheets, entitled “Repair Services”. Repair Services shall include the hourly rate of two (2) Technicians and the required vehicles as specified in Section 7 and 12 herein, with the exception of MOT which shall be applied on an as-needed basis and compensated in accordance with the unit prices under Section D entitled “Maintenance of Traffic for Repair Services and Emergency Services” on the Pricing Sheets. Repairs will be measured and paid for each hour the Contractor staff (and required vehicle) is on the site for the Repair Service at the Contractor’s price in Section C of the Pricing Sheet.

- E. Delete Part V, Page 11, Section 7 entitled “Electrical Contractor License” in its entirety
- F. In Part V, Page 11, Section 8 entitled “Personnel Requirements”, delete the second paragraph in its entirety.

**II. BIDDER'S QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Bidders. The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Bidders to the Port Authority. It addresses only those questions, which the Port Authority has deemed to require additional information and/or clarification. The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Bidder does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms.

The furnishing of such information by the Port Authority shall not create or be deemed to create any obligation or liability upon it for any reason whatsoever and each Bidder, by submitting its Bid, expressly agrees that it has not relied upon the foregoing information, and that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.

<b>Question # 2</b>	Please provide specifications or a part number for the wireless communication links requested in item number B4. Daktronics does not supply this product.
<b>Answer # 2</b>	This product does not presently exist and will be purchased from the selected Contractor. Refer to: Part V, page 5, Section B entitled “ITS Replacement and Modification of ITS Components” and Part V, page 6, Section C entitled “Repair Services”.
<b>Question #3</b>	Please clarify that the hourly rate in Part V, Page 6, Section C for repair services and Part V, Page 8, Section C for Emergency Call-in Services includes (2) technicians. So basically if (2) men work an (8) hour day we will only be compensated for (8) hours of the given unit price.

<b>Answer #3</b>	Refer to Part V, page 8, section E) Emergency Call-In Services and CHANGES/MODIFICATION “D” above
<b>Question #4</b>	Will the Port Authority provide a yard to store our trucks and equipment?
<b>Answer #4</b>	No
<b>Question #5</b>	Please clarify. In attachment A which VMS units are the parking lot type and which are the ones on the sign structures.
<b>Answer #5</b>	The following Device IDs are associated with the parking garage (East Parking Garage): LGA-1, LGA-2, LGA-3, LGA-4, LGA-5, and LGA-6. The remaining are either roadside or on sign structures.

This communication should be initiated by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission.

In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
