ADDENDUM #2

To prospective Bidders on Bid # 46023 - Refuse Removal, Recycling and Disposal Services at Newark Liberty International Airport

Due back on 6/16/16, no later than 11:00 A.M.

I. CHANGES TO BID DOCUMENTS

The following changes are hereby made to the Bid Documents:

- In Part IV, “Signature Sheet, Name And Residence Of Principals Sheet And Pricing Sheet(s)”, delete “Section A: Recyclables - Pricing Sheet – Year One (1)” and “Section A: Recyclables - Pricing Sheet – Year Two (2) in their entirety and replace them with the attached “Section A: Recyclables - Pricing Sheet – Year One (1) - Revised 6/3/16” and “Section A: Recyclables - Pricing Sheet – Year Two (2) – Revised 6/3/16”.
- Add the attached “Item A-5 - Calculation Of Contractor’s Price Per Cubic Yard” immediately after Page 25 of Part IV, “Signature Sheet, Name And Residence Of Principals Sheet And Pricing Sheet(s)”.
- In Part V, “Specifications”, Page 5, Section 5, “Item Specifications/Locations”, “Item A-1 – 15-Cubic Yard Compactor Terminal B (Loading Dock)”, in the first sentence, after the word “self-contained”, add the words “or breakaway”.
- In Part V, “Specifications”, Section 5., “Item Specifications/Locations”, add the following paragraph immediately below “Item A-4 – 96 Gallon Toters – Various Port Authority Offices at the Facility”:

“Item A-5 – 6-Cubic Yard Containers – Buildings 79 and 80

Two (2), six (6)-cubic-yard Containers with lid to be delivered and placed by the Contractor, one (1) located at Building 70 and one (1) located at Building 80. The Contractor shall perform Pickups two (2) days per week, Tuesday and Friday, between the hours of 12:01 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. unless otherwise directed by the Manager. **These Containers will contain Mixed Paper”.**

II. BIDDERS' QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Bidders. The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Bidders to the Port Authority. It addresses only those questions, which the Port Authority has deemed to require additional information and/or clarification. The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Bidders does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms.

The Port Authority makes no representations, warranties or guarantees that the information contained herein is accurate, complete or timely or that such information accurately represents the conditions that would be encountered during the performance of the Contract. The furnishing of such information by the Port Authority shall not create or be deemed to create any obligation or liability upon it for any reason whatsoever and each Bidder, by submitting its Bid, expressly agrees that it has not relied upon the foregoing information, and that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.

The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.

<i>Question #2</i>	Can I provide a portable Compactor for Items A-1 and E-1?
<i>Answer #2</i>	Yes. Please see "Changes to Bid Documents" third bulleted item, above and Part V, "Specifications", Page 10, Item E-1, "30 Cubic Yard Compactor – North Yard", first sentence.
<i>Question #3</i>	Who is responsible for providing the CMS Alert system for the Compactors, Items A-1 and E-1?
<i>Answer #3</i>	The Contractor is responsible for providing the CMS Alert System. Please see Part V, "Specifications", Page 5, "Item A-1 - 15-Cubic-Yard Compactor - Terminal B (Loading Dock)", Paragraph c., second sentence, and Page 10, Item E-1, "30 Cubic Yard Compactor – North Yard", Paragraph c., second sentence.
<i>Question #4</i>	How many cubic yards is the Compactor, Item E-1?
<i>Answer #4</i>	Item E-1 is 30-cubic yards. Please see Part V, "Specifications", Page 10, "IV, Thirty (30) Cubic-Yard Open-Top Compactor Container (On-Call Basis)", Item E-1, "30 Cubic Yard Compactor – North Yard".
<i>Question #5</i>	How will the pickup of tires be handled?
<i>Answer #5</i>	The Contractor' pickup of tires will be paid through "Extra Work", Paragraph 8 in Part III, "Contract Specific Terms and Conditions"
