## ADDENDUM # 2

To prospective Bidder(s) on Bid # 46104 for Weekend Shuttle Bus Service for PATH – One (1) Year Contract

Due back on 6/16/2016, no later than 11:00AM

Originally due on 6/7/2016, no later than 11:00AM

### I. CHANGES/MODIFICATIONS

**The following changes/modifications are hereby made to the solicitation documents:**

- a) Part II entitled “Contract Specific Information For Bidders”, page 4, after paragraph 11, add the following:

#### **12. Information for Bidders**

As more fully described herein, this bid, BID #46104, generally seeks Weekend Shuttle Bus Services with routes including New York and New Jersey locations. BID #46268 generally seeks Weekend Shuttle Bus services with a route within New York City; between downtown & midtown NY

Bidders are advised that these are not duplicate bid documents. One does not replace another. Bid #46104 and Bid #46268 are independent, standalone bid documents that shall be treated as unique bid opportunities.

*However, Bidders are advised that it is the Authority’s intent to award only one contract to either the lowest responsible and responsive from Bid#46104 OR the lowest responsible and responsive bidder from Bid #46268. The Authority is not seeking to award contracts from both bid documents. Bidders that are capable of performing the services required under either bid are encouraged to bid on both.*

Bidders are advised to keep this fact in mind when making determinations for material and labor availability.

Bidders are advised to read the subject bid documents carefully and follow the instructions specific to each. If intending to respond to both offerings, two separate responses will be required each consistent with the instructions, date and times contained in the subject Bid instructions. For the avoidance of doubt, Bidders are advised not to combine any responses between the two bids.

Note - The above statements are offered solely for clarification purposes to avoid confusion. Nothing stated here shall be deemed to remove or replace any other rights stated elsewhere in the bid documents.”

b) Part IV entitled “ Signature Sheet, Name And Residence Of Principals Sheet And Pricing Sheet(S), Table Of Contents”, page 5 after “Award will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the total estimated bid price” add the following:

This bid, BID #46104 generally seeks Weekend Shuttle Bus Services with routes including New York and New Jersey locations. The Port Authority has a separate bid, BID #46268, which generally seeks Weekend Shuttle Bus services with a route within New York City; between downtown & midtown NY.

Bidders are advised that these are not duplicate bid documents. One does not replace another. Bid #46104 and Bid #46268 are independent, standalone bid documents that shall be treated as unique bid opportunities. Pricing may not be combined, spread or otherwise be contingent upon one another between the two bids.

*Bidders are advised that it is the Authority’s intent to award only one contract - to either the lowest responsible and responsive from Bid#46104 OR the lowest responsible and responsive bidder from Bid #46268. The Authority is not seeking to award contracts from both bid documents and Bidders should submit pricing accordingly.*

## **II. BIDDER'S QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Bidders. The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Bidders to the Port Authority. It addresses only those questions, which the Port Authority has deemed to require additional information and/or clarification. The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Bidders does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms.

The Port Authority makes no representations, warranties or guarantees that the information contained herein is accurate, complete or timely or that such information accurately represents the conditions that would be encountered during the performance of the Contract. The furnishing of such information by the Port Authority shall not create or be deemed to create any obligation or liability upon it for any reason whatsoever and each Bidder, by submitting its Bid, expressly agrees that it has not relied upon the foregoing information, and that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.

The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.

<b><i>Question #1</i></b>	I see there is a second bid for bus services with a different Route. Will the Port Authority make two awards for weekend shuttle bus services?
<b><i>Answer #1</i></b>	No. Refer to Changes/Modifications a) above.

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission.

In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
