I. CHANGES/MODIFICATIONS

The following changes/modifications are hereby made to the solicitation documents:

1. Section 3.5 of the RFPQ, titled Code of Ethics for Port Authority Vendors, is hereby deleted and replaced in its entirety with the following:

“3.5 Code of Ethics for Port Authority Vendors

The Port Authority has adopted a Code of Ethics for Port Authority Vendors (the “Code”). The Code will be a part of the agreement resulting from the anticipated RFP. The Code can be found at <https://www.panynj.gov/business-opportunities/become-vendor.html>”

2. Attachment D and Attachment E to the RFPQ are hereby deleted in their entirety.

II. RESPONDENT'S QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Respondent(s). The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Respondents to the Port Authority. It addresses only those questions which the Port Authority has deemed to require additional information and/or clarification. The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Respondent does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms.

The Port Authority makes no representations, warranties or guarantees that the information contained herein is accurate, complete or timely. The furnishing of such information by the Port Authority shall not create or be deemed to create any obligation or liability upon it for any reason whatsoever and each Respondent, by submitting its prequalification requirements, expressly agrees that it has not relied upon the foregoing information, and that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or

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limit the effect of the warranties of the Respondent required by the Request for Prequalification, the RFP to be issued to prequalified Respondents, or the contract resulting from the RFP and the Respondent agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.

The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.

The Port Authority acknowledges receipt of additional questions that are not addressed herein as they are not directly relevant to prequalification activities. These questions focus more on proposed scope of the contract to be awarded following the prequalification and RFP process. Many of these questions will be clarified in the subsequent documents that will be sent to prequalified firms. If prequalified respondents, upon reviewing the RFP specifics, do have further questions, they are to submit them during the RFP question and answer period.

<i>Question #32</i>	Section 3.5 of the RFPQ indicates that the Port Authority's "Code of Ethics for Port Authority Vendors" is attached as Attachment D and that the Compliance Certification, attached as Attachment E must be executed. Can you please confirm that Attachment D contains the entire Code of Ethics for Port Authority Vendors and that both Attachments D and E must be signed?
<i>Answer #32</i>	Please see Sections 1 and 2 of Section I - Changes/Modifications above. At this time, there is no certification required to be signed with respect to the Code of Ethics for Port Authority Vendors.

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your response upon submission.

In case any Respondent fails to conform to these instructions, its response will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
