Dear Sir or Madam:

The following questions were received from an RFP recipient. The questions and corresponding Authority answers are provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

1. Please provide the name of the software and/or IT solution(s) that the Port Authority is currently using to maintain their grants and associated documentation.
 - A. *A specific grants database or system does not exist. The Authority has both a Sequel Server and an Oracle TMI/Cognos database that currently maintains some, but not all, of the subject information. As noted in Attachment A, III., Page 3, B. 1., part of the required services is to “Develop and maintain a Grants Management Database”.*
2. If a firm is selected as a prime and has no subconsultants as part of its proposal response but it is later determined that the firm could handle a specific Task Order if it brought a subconsultant on to its team, would that firm be allowed to bring the subconsultant on after the initial award of the IQC?
 - A. *Yes, for the category(ies) the selected firm is pre-qualified to perform.*

The due date for receipt of proposals remains **2:00 P.M. on December 5, 2014.**
