**LOT NO. 1 – DESCRIPTION**

Spent lead and brass derived from Winchester Ranger 9mm luger ammunition. The bullet is approximately five percent (5%) copper and ninety five percent (95%) lead. The casing and primer are brass, comprising approximately seventy percent (70%) copper and thirty percent (30%) zinc. There is a negligible amount of nickel (from the plating). Some of the spent casings are .223 caliber brass, not plated. This type of brass makes up approximately five percent (5%) of the total weight. There is a possibility that some unspent bullets may be included with the spent lead and brass.

**Gross weights stated are estimated.** The estimated weight is based on the average weight for a barrel of lead and a barrel of brass. An estimated average weight for a barrel of lead is 427.2 lbs. and for a barrel of brass the estimated average weight is 284.2 lbs. The total weight of each commodity has been reduced by five percent (5%) to calculate the estimated total weight.

There are 49 20-gallon barrels spent lead, and 28 20-gallon barrels of spent brass.
