The Port Authority of New York & New Jersey hereby amends the subject Request for Proposal (RFP) letter, dated December 11, 2014 as follows:

In the RFP Letter:

**Please Note:** The due date for receipt of Proposals has been changed to 2:00 p.m., February 13, 2015.

Page 1, Section I. Proposer Requirements, delete subparagraph B. in its entirety and replace with the following:

“ B. Minimum Staff Criteria (Must be current, full-time, permanent staff):

1. A minimum of fifty (50) construction management, construction inspection personnel, with at least two (2) of the total personnel must be Licensed Engineers in the State of NY and/or NJ.
2. Of the 50 construction management staff noted above at least 5 members of your Construction Management Team shall have certification in each area of the following specialties:
  - a) ACI Concrete Construction Special Inspector
  - b) ICC Certification as a Structural Steel and Bolting Inspector

Of the 50 construction management staff noted above at least 2 members of your Construction Management Team shall have certification in each area of the following specialties:

- c) NICET Level II Fire Alarm System
- d) NICET Level II Fire Protection Inspection and Testing of Water Based Systems
- e) NACE Level I minimum

3. Certificate of Authorization to practice Professional Engineering in the states of either New York or New Jersey. “

Page 4, Section III. Submission Requirements, subparagraph G, second paragraph, fourth line, delete “the total number of hours to be spent by each of them in the performance of each task”.
