6.E Conditions for the submission of a request for Pre-qualification	14	Subcontractors	Will qualified integrators be allowed to add or change subcontractors after submission of this RFPQ?	If the Respondent intends to utilize a subcontractor, the Authority will consider the relevant experience of the subcontractor in determining whether the Respondent has met the experience requirement set forth in this subsection. In the event that a Respondent satisfies the minimum experience requirement based on the experience of the subcontractor, the Port Authority will re-evaluate its decision to prequalify the Respondent if the proposed subcontractor arrangement is withdrawn by the Respondent. If the Respondent is a joint venture, the Authority will consider the experience of each of the joint venture partners in determining whether the Respondent has met the minimum experience requirement set forth in this subsection.
