16.	<b>QUESTION</b>	Should the Staffing Plan (Attachment E) be included in the Technical Proposal or be part of the separately sealed cost proposal?
	<b>ANSWER</b>	Include revised Staffing Plan (Attachment E) attached with Technical Proposal.
17.	<b>QUESTION</b>	Form A2 (DBE Participation Plan and Affirmation Statement) requests cost information. Should Form A2 be included in the Technical Proposal (RFP Section G. Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program), as requested or in the separately sealed cost proposal?
	<b>ANSWER</b>	Submit all DBE documents with the Cost Proposal.
18.	<b>QUESTION</b>	Should the cost proposal data be included on the USBs, or should separate USBs be produced for the cost proposals?
	<b>ANSWER</b>	Submit USB containing the cost proposal with the envelope containing the cost information. Submit only one (1) USB for this purpose.
