The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey hereby amends the subject Request for Proposals (RFP), dated August 25, 2017, as follows:

RFP Letter

1. On page 8, Section III “Submission Requirements,” item J, in the second paragraph, insert the following after the first sentence:

“unless the firm selected for performance of the subject services has a Port Authority approved mitigation plan in place to address any potential conflict between the services under this Agreement and the other contemplated services. Subconsultants are not expressly precluded.”

The following question is from an RFP recipient. The question and the corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate.

**Question #1:** As a subconsultant on a team providing project/program management services, would the firm be precluded from future projects involving design-related services under the JFK Redevelopment Program?

**Answer #1:** Please see above under amendment to the subject RFP. In addition, please refer to paragraph 30, Conflict of Interest, in the Agreement.
