"After chemical pre-treatment, the Contractor must water blast and vacuum."

Question #5	Are light towers required, or are vehicle mounted lights permitted on the water blasting truck as long as there is sufficient lighting supplied?
Answer #5	Refer to Part V, Specifications, section 5 entitled "Rubber Removal, Equipment and Standards".
Question #6	Does the Authority provide escort vehicles, if needed?
Answer #6	Refer to Part V, Specifications, section 6 entitled "Airport Operations and Conditions".
Question #7	Is prevailing wage required in this Bid?
Answer #7	No.
