ADDENDUM NO. 3

TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS ON CONTRACT **PN-654.072** – PORT NEWARK – CORBIN STREET/BERTH 3 RECONSTRUCTION OF CULVERT

The following changes are hereby made in the Contract Documents for the subject Contract.

This communication should be physically annexed to back cover of the book and initialled by each bidder before submitting his bid.

In case any bidder fails to conform to these instructions, his Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialled.

CHANGES IN THE CONTRACT BOOKLET

Page iv - Following "78. CONSTRUCTION SITE SECURITY REQUIREMENTS.....91", insert new line "78A. MATERIALS FURNISHED BY THE AUTHORITY.....91".

Page 91 - Following the last paragraph of clause 78. CONSTRUCTION SITE SECURITY REQUIREMENTS, insert the following new clause:
"78A. MATERIALS FURNISHED BY THE AUTHORITY
The Authority will furnish to the Contractor for installation by him in the permanent construction the following materials:
A. 43 Pairs 50 Feet AZ 38-700N Sheet Piles
B. 25 50 Feet 18" Pipe Pile 0.5" Thickness (24 of the pipe piles have pile tip welded to them)

It is presently expected but not guaranteed that the foregoing materials will be furnished to the Contractor by the times required for their installation.

Materials furnished to the Contractor shall be examined by him at the time they are furnished to him, and if there is any shortage, damage or other defect, the Contractor shall at that time bring it specifically in writing to the attention of the Engineer. Any shortage, damage or defect so brought to the Engineer's attention and acknowledged by him will be corrected by the Authority. If no shortage, damage or other defect is so brought to the attention of and acknowledged by the Engineer at the time said materials are furnished to the Contractor, the materials shall thereafter conclusively be deemed to have been satisfactory in all respects,

provided that if the Contractor demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Engineer that there was a shortage, damage or defect at the time the materials were furnished to the Contractor and that such fact could not reasonably have been ascertained at that time, then the shortage, damage or defect will be corrected by the Authority.

From the date the foregoing materials are furnished to the Contractor they shall form part of the materials included in the risks assumed by the Contractor as provided in subparagraph A of the clause of the Form of Contract entitled "Risks Assumed by the Contractor".

All materials or portions thereof in excess of those actually required in the permanent construction and which in the opinion of the Engineer may be suitable for use by the Authority shall be returned to the Authority at a location at the construction site designated by the Engineer upon the completion of the Work or when there is no longer any need for this material, whichever may first occur.

The Contractor at his own expense, shall furnish all materials required by the Contract Drawings and Specifications with the exception of those materials expressly provided to be furnished to the Contractor by the Authority in accordance with this numbered Section."

Page 117 - In A. 3. b. of clause 107. REQUIREMENTS FOR CRANES AND DERRICKS, delete "more" and substitute therefor "less".
