I. CHANGES TO BID DOCUMENTS

The following changes are hereby made to the bid documents

- The bid due date has been extended to 5/8/15, no later than 11:00 A.M.
- In Part V, "Specifications" Section 3. "Removal and Disposal of Sludge, Dirt and Debris", delete the sentence that reads "The Contractor is responsible for removing the catch basin covers and the slotted drain covers and replacing and securing the same after the Work is completed." and replace it with the sentence: "Port Authority staff will unbolt the slotted drain covers for the Contractor's removal and re-secure them after the Contractor has replaced them."
- In Part V, "Specifications", Section 10, "Materials, Supplies and Equipment", after the final sentence, add the sentence: "The Contractor may stage and retain its required containers and vacuum boxes at the Facility for waste removal while performing the Work under this Contract, but must remove them upon completion of the Work."

II. BIDDERS' QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The following information is available in response to questions submitted by prospective Bidders. The responses should not be deemed to answer all questions, which have been submitted by Bidders to the Port Authority. It addresses only those questions, which the Port Authority has deemed to require additional information and/or clarification. The fact that information has not been supplied with respect to any questions asked by a Bidders does not mean or imply, nor should it be deemed to mean or imply, any meaning, construction, or implication with respect to the terms of this Bid.

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The Port Authority makes no representations, warranties or guarantees that the information contained herein is accurate, complete or timely or that such information accurately represents the conditions that would be encountered during the performance of the Contract. The furnishing of such information by the Port Authority shall not create or be deemed to create any obligation or liability upon it for any reason whatsoever and each Bidder, by submitting its Bid, expressly agrees that it has not relied upon the foregoing information, and that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever. Accordingly, nothing contained herein and no representation, statement or promise, of the Port Authority, its Commissioners, officers, agents, representatives, or employees, oral or in writing, shall impair or limit the effect of the warranties of the Bidder required by this Bid or Contract and the Bidder agrees that it shall not hold the Port Authority liable or responsible therefor in any manner whatsoever.

The Questions and Answers numbering sequence will be continued sequentially in any forthcoming Addenda that may be issued.

<i>Question #5</i>	Are all catch basins at particular site made available for cleaning during a continuous, multi-day, semi-annual mobilization?
<i>Answer #5</i>	The Port Authority will attempt to schedule the cleaning of all items at the same time. See Part V, "Specifications", Section 6," Scheduling of Work".
<i>Question #6</i>	Are all slotted drains at particular site made available for cleaning during a continuous, multi-day, semi-annual mobilization?
<i>Answer #6</i>	The Port Authority will attempt to schedule the cleaning of all items at the same time. "See Part V, "Specifications", Section 6," Scheduling of Work".
<i>Question #7</i>	What is approximate average number of catch basins cleaned per day by current vendor?
<i>Answer #7</i>	The approximate average number of catch basins cleaned is 20 per day. There is no guarantee what the future average number of catch basins to be cleaned per day will be.
<i>Question #8</i>	Please confirm no bid security or performance bond is a requirement for this bid.
<i>Answer #8</i>	No bid security or performance bond is required for this bid.
<i>Question #9</i>	MBE /WBE – good intentions document, please confirm when this is requirement – upon bid submittal or upon award.
<i>Answer #9</i>	Any participation plans should be submitted with the Bid. See Part I, "Standard Information For Bidders" Section 18, "M/WBE Subcontracting Provisions".

This communication should be initialed by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission.

In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
