ADDENDUM # 6

To prospective Bidder(s) on Bid # 47340 for Inspection, Maintenance, Testing, Repair, and Central Station Monitoring Services for the Fire Alarm and Suppression Systems at Staten Island Bridges - Three (3) Year Contract

I. CHANGES/MODIFICATIONS

The following changes/modifications are hereby made to the solicitation documents:

a) Part III “Contract Specific Terms and Conditions”, Page 5, entitled “Liquidated Damages”, after item “VI,” “Failure to wear uniform/ID,” add the following:

vii. Failure to Submit Proof of Certification

If the Contractor fails to submit proof of certification by Siemens Building Technologies per Part V (“the Specifications”), then the amount payable hereunder shall be reduced by two hundred dollars (\$200) for each day or part thereof such proof of certification is not submitted.

viii. Failure to Submit Proof of Certified Technician

If the Contractor fails to submit certification by Siemens Building Technologies showing that each of the Contractor’s staff and/or any and all Subcontractor’s staff performing Work on Siemens Systems are certified to program and repair Siemens Systems installed at the Facility per Part V (“the Specifications”), then the amount payable hereunder shall be reduced by one hundred dollars (\$100) for each day or part thereof such proof of certification is not submitted.

b) Part V “Specifications”, Section 2, entitled “Work Required by Specifications”, delete the paragraph beginning at the bottom of page 4 in its entirety and replace with the following below:

The Contractor shall work either directly or through Subcontractors pre-approved by the Manager when programming or repairing Siemens Systems. The Contractor and its Subcontractor(s) shall ensure that all personnel working on Siemens Systems shall be certified and authorized to program and repair Siemens Systems installed at the Facility, and to make any necessary factory-authorized repairs, site specific software and hardware changes, modifications and upgrades to Systems' components and graphics deemed necessary for the Systems' operations or as directed by the Manager.

The Contractor shall ensure, (A) if prior to Contract award, within seven (7) days of the Manager's request, and (B) if at any time during the Contract performance, within one (1) day of the Manager's request, that:

- (1) Its Subcontractor(s) and their staff are certified by Siemens Building Technologies; and
- (2) The Contractor submits a) documentation from Siemens Building Technologies, Inc. confirming that the Contractor and/or its Subcontractor(s) are authorized to service and program the System; and a) a copy of the Siemens certificate(s) showing that each of the Contractor's staff and/or any and all Subcontractor's staff performing Work on Siemens Systems are certified to program and repair Siemens Systems installed at the Facility. The Contractor and/or Subcontractor must remain a Siemens authorized service provider(s) for the duration of this Contract, including any option period and/or extension period.

This communication shall be initialed by you and annexed to your Bid upon submission.

In case any Bidder fails to conform to these instructions, its Bid will nevertheless be construed as though this communication had been so physically annexed and initialed.
