**SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF EXPERT PROFESSIONAL PROGRAM AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE PORT AUTHORITY BUS TERMINAL REPLACEMENT PROGRAM ON AN “AS-NEEDED” BASIS (RFP# 51326)– ADDENDA #6**

Dear Sir or Madam:

The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey hereby amends the subject Request for Proposals (RFP), dated October 23, 2017 as follows:

In the Attachment A (Scope of Work):

1. On page 2, under Section II. Scope of Work, first paragraph, third line down, after “planning” insert “(including preliminary engineering related to the EIS), and potentially”.
2. On page 3, under Section II. Scope of Work, seventh paragraph, first line, after “EIS”, insert “, which includes completion of Base Scope and Optional Task #1 below,”.
3. On page 3, under Section II. Scope of Work, seventh paragraph, eighth line, after “duration of the agreement.”, skip a line and insert the following paragraph:

*“The base term of the Agreement for performance of this Scope of Work (Base Scope and Optional Task #1) is a four (4) year period from the Notice to Proceed. Individual Notice to Proceeds will be issued for the Base Scope and Optional Task #1. The Authority reserves the right to extend the Agreement for two (2) additional one (1)-year periods. The Authority also reserves the right to extend the Agreement for the incorporation of Optional Task #2, below. Notification of exercising Optional Task #2 shall be in writing from the Authority’s Representative, with Procurement’s concurrence.”*
4. On page 4, under Section II. Scope of Work, under subitem “Contract Phasing”, second bullet point, delete “TASKS A to H” and replace with “TASKS A to G”.

The following question is from an RFP recipient. The question and the corresponding Authority answer is provided for your information and use, as appropriate:

1. **Question:** Do proposers need to fill out Exhibit I “Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Contract Provisions”?

*Answer:* Yes, all proposers must fill out Exhibit I and submit it with the proposal.
