Sealed bids for the following contract will be received by The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey in the office of the Director of Procurement, Attn: Bid Custodian, 2 Montgomery Street, 3rd Floor, Jersey City, NJ 07302, until 2:30 PM on the date indicated where the proposals will then be publicly opened and read in the Bid Room.

Contract documents may be seen at the Contract Desk on the 3rd Floor, 3 Gateway Center, Newark, NJ and may be obtained upon receipt of a non-refundable payment of \$100.00 per set. **If contract documents are not immediately available, prospective bidders are encouraged to pre-order the contract documents by sending the payment of \$100.00 per set in advance. The contract documents will be shipped by overnight delivery at no additional cost as soon as they become available.** Only company checks or money orders payable to the order of The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey will be accepted. Contract BT-200.300 – Port Authority Bus Terminal – Construction Management/General Contracting Services For Port Authority Bus Terminal Service Improvements. Estimate Range: \$60M - \$70M. **Bids Due: Monday, September 8, 2014.** The work under this contract consists generally of construction management and general conditions construction for replacement of doors; renovation of restrooms; replacement of architectural finishes such as ceilings, floors, and cladding; replacement of light fixtures, rehabilitation of elevators and escalators; upgrade of the visual paging and master clock systems; installation of signage; leak repairs; conversion of parking lots to bus staging areas, modifying the traffic barrier between two bus ramps to create a bypass lane; and creation of additional bus gates at street level and related Work at the Port Authority Bus Terminal and adjacent Lincoln Tunnel properties in New York City, New York, all as directed by Engineer and in accordance with Work Order(s) issued by the Engineer.
