TITLE: Repair, replacement and ongoing preventative and remedial maintenance to support the Multi-Facility Security Systems and Equipment (MFSSE), consisting of Lenel OnGuard Computerized Access Control System' (CACs), Verint Nextiva Closed Circuit Television (CCTV), identification/badging, surveillance, analytic and associated field equipment at JFK, LGA, EWR and SWF.

DESCRIPTION: The Port Authority is seeking to retain a single firm to provide services and materials for the enhancement and maintenance of its Multi-Facility Security Systems and Equipment (MFSSE). The Contractor shall be responsible for the service, repair and/or device replacement and ongoing preventative and remedial maintenance to support the MFSSE. The MFSSE consists of Lenel OnGuard Computerized Access Control System (CACs), Verint Nextiva Closed Circuit Television (CCTV), identification/badging, surveillance, analytic and associated field equipment

3. The third Facility Inspection is scheduled to be held at Newark Liberty International Airport, Port Authority Administration Building # 1 Conrad Road (off Brewster Road), 2nd Floor, Small General Manager's Conference Room on Friday , May 17, 2019 at 9:00 a.m.
