Sealed bids for the following contract will be received by The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey in the Procurement Department, Attn: Bid Custodian, 2 Montgomery Street, 3rd Floor, Jersey City, NJ 07302, until 2:30 PM on the date indicated where the proposals will then be publicly opened and read in the Bid Room.

Contract documents may be seen at the Contract Desk on the 3rd Floor, 3 Gateway Center, Newark, NJ and may be obtained upon receipt of a non-refundable payment of \$100.00 per set. **If contract documents are not immediately available, prospective bidders are encouraged to pre-order the contract documents by sending the payment of \$100.00 per set in advance. The contract documents will be shipped by overnight delivery at no additional cost as soon as they become available.** Only company checks or money orders payable to the order of The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey will be accepted. Estimate Range: \$1M - \$5M. **Bids Due: Thursday, August 29, 2013.**

The work under this contract consists generally of miscellaneous facility improvements, including: (1) repair, rehabilitation, demolition and construction of various interior and exterior building systems including: curtain wall, roof, concrete slab, ceiling, floor tile, interior finishes, construction painting, mechanical, HVAC, electrical, electronics, sprinkler, plumbing, conveying systems, interior landscaping and utility runs within buildings; (2) site work, including rehabilitation, demolition and construction of concrete and/or asphalt paving, landscaping, concrete pads, sidewalks, curbs, erosion control, cracks and slurry seals, irrigation, pavement striping, concrete traffic barriers, signage, traffic signals, electrical/communications ductbanks and wiring, drainage structures and piping, guide rails, exterior screening, exterior demising walls, fencing, and various utility runs to building lines; and (3) maintenance and protection of pedestrian and vehicular traffic, all as directed by the Engineer and in accordance with Work Order(s) issued by the Engineer.
