REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE PERFORMANCE OF EXPERT PROFESSIONAL ARCHITECTURAL/ENGINEERING DESIGN AND RELATED SERVICES AS REQUESTED ON A “CALL-IN” BASIS DURING 2015 - 2018

Firms interested in performing professional architectural and/or engineering design and related services for The Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, as the need arises during 2015 through 2018, are encouraged to complete the Engineering Department's Professional Service Firm Questionnaire (PSFQ) available on the Authority's website at <https://psfq.panynj.gov/pls/apexapexapps/f?p=146:3>. The completed PSFQ serves as a statement of qualifications, and is used to prequalify firms for receipt of Requests for Proposals for the performance of said services. In those instances where the contemplated services are federally funded, in whole or in part, the requirements of the sponsoring agency will be included in the solicitation documents, as appropriate, and as required.

The PSFQ has been modified as follows -

Staff Types in the following disciplines have been modified:

Architectural - CADD - Environmental Engineering -
Geotechnical Engineering - Mechanical Engineering - Sustainable Design

Project Types in the following disciplines have been modified:

Architecture - Geotechnical Engineering - Mechanical Engineering - Sustainable Design

If your firm provides any such services, carefully review these changes, and revise your questionnaire accordingly. Failure to do so can result in your firm missing an important opportunity, and shall not serve as an encumbrance on the Authority.

Those firms deemed most qualified based on the information provided by them in the PSFQ may be issued a Request for Proposal(s) for performance of the subject services.

To ensure consideration of your firm for all applicable categories under the subject program, new or revised questionnaires must be completed no later than **April 14, 2014**.

This advertisement is intended to target all firms seeking consideration for performance of the subject services. Such firms include those that: 1) seek to be new service providers, 2) are currently in the PSFQ database but want to add to, or must now modify, information previously provided, or 3) have a PSFQ on file that is approaching the end of its five-year validity period, and are therefore required to update their PSFQ at this time.
